1. When and where were you born?

I was born in Edinburgh, Scotland on 3rd March, 1847.

2. What were your professions?

I was a scientist and an inventor.

3. Did you have any other talents?

I had a talent for art, poetry and music and I learned to play the piano without a teacher.

4. What happened when you were fifteen and sixteen?

When I was fifteen I finished school and at the age of sixteen I worked as a music teacher in an academy in Scotland.

5. What did you do in 1870?

In 1870 I moved to Canada and I started experiments with electricity and sound.

6. What did you invent and when?

I invented the telephone in 1876.

Alexander Graham Bell died on 2nd August, 1922 in Nova Scotia at the age of 75.
